Previous ACS guidelines called for screening every three years with a Pap smear alone beginning at age 21 and recommended HPV testing combined with a Pap smear (co-testing) every five years as the preferred screening method for women ages 30 to 65.

### Guidelines - ASCCP

A Pap smear, also called a Pap test, is a procedure to test for cervical cancer in women. A Pap smear involves collecting cells from your cervix — the lower, narrow end of your uterus that's at the top of your vagina. Detecting cervical cancer early with a Pap smear gives you a greater chance at a cure.

The ASCUS Pap smear result might seem frightening, however, an ASCUS result is not dangerous in most cases. It does not necessarily mean there is an immediate risk of cervical cancer. A small percentage of the time, atypical cells could become cervical lesions, but this is rare. As a general rule, in a large percentage of women, ASCUS Pap test results will tend to become normal within three months.

The American Cancer Society recommends that individuals with a cervix follow these guidelines to help find cervical cancer early. Following these guidelines can also find pre-cancers, which can be treated to keep cervical cancer from starting.

New American Cancer Society cervical cancer guidelines ...

In contrast to the updated ACS guidelines, for example, a 2018 U.S Preventive Service Task Force (USPSTF) recommendation calls for starting screening at age 21 years with Pap smear alone. At ages 30 through 65, USPSTF recommends HPV testing every five years or Pap smear alone every three years with co-testing as an alternative option.

The American Cancer Society (ACS) has updated its guidelines for cervical cancer screening. The new guidelines are for people with a cervix with an average risk of cervical cancer. For people aged 25 to 65 years, the preferred screening recommendation is to get a primary human papillomavirus (HPV) test every 5 years.

New recommendations from the American Cancer Society now emphasize HPV tests over Pap smears for cervical cancer screening. The guidelines also raise the age for initial screening from 21 to 25.

The 2018 USPSTF guideline included HPV testing alone, cotesting, and Pap testing as equal options. The difference in the new ACS guidelines is that they elevate HPV testing alone over the other two tests. Why does the new guideline recommend screening starting at age 25, instead of age 21?

Screening Guidelines - ASCCP

The new ACS guidelines argue that the HPV test should be the "preferred method of testing" as the United States is in a "transition period" away from the "former mainstay" of Pap smears.

The final ACS guidelines do address CETC concerns that only HPV testing platforms approved for primary screening be used for that purpose, in addition to referring providers to appropriate ASCCP management guidelines for women with abnormal screening tests.

In addition, the ACS now recommends that only women ages 25 through 65 should undergo cervical cancer screening. The previous set of guidelines, released in 2012, recommended that women ages 21 through 65 get a Pap smear every three years or get both a Pap smear and an HPV test—a practice known as “co-testing”—every five years.
