Baptist ushers give the first impression of the church to visitors. The primary responsibility of an usher is to greet churchgoers as they arrive at the church and again at the worship service. They can also escort guests to their seats, if assistance is needed. Bulletins are usually handed out by ushers at the doors of the church sanctuary.

What Are the Duties of an Usher at a Baptist Church ...

An usher must avoid long conversations that could overlook providing a handshake, smile, and greeting to everyone who is in attendance. An usher must never place his/her hands on the opposite sex other than a friendly handshake or helping someone at their request. Ask before touching.

An usher signals prayer by crossing his right arm over his left, with each hand touching the opposite elbow. When it is time for the ushers to assume their stations, the lead usher moves his right hand in an arc from his left cheek to his right hip, which is also the signal for asking how many chairs are available in a row.
