Trigger Point Massage for Dogs | Ojai School of Canine Massage

A myofascial trigger point can be defined as a hyperirritable spot located within a taut band in skeletal muscle. 13 The presence of MTPs within muscle can be a source of pain and dysfunction in dogs; however, limited information exists in veterinary literature. The emergence of the disciplines of veterinary rehabilitation and sports medicine demand a better understanding of the role MTPs play in muscle pain and dysfunction.

Canine Sports Therapy

In canine physical therapy, numerous manual therapies are utilized to decrease a pet's musculoskeletal pain. Trigger point dry needling is such a technique. Muscle and connective fascial tissue (myofascia junctions) can develop adhesions, contractions and spasm resulting in a viscous cyclic pathway of neuromuscular stimulation, muscle contractions, followed by more stimulation.

The sensory component of a trigger point can be appreciated by direct palpation of that point. Gentle palpation of the taut band or trigger point often leads to the dog reacting with a jump with a look toward the side of palpation. More vigorous palpation commonly results in vocalization with a menace and escape response.
