How to Cite a Newspaper Article With No Author | Pen and ...

Online sources such as newspaper articles are cited in a bibliography in the same way as other print sources. List the author's last name, followed by a comma, followed by the first name and a period. For example, "Wright, Steven." If there is no author, do not write anything in that spot.

If you used a print version of the newspaper article and include a direct quote in your paper, place a comma after the year of publication in your in-text citation. Type a space after the comma then the page number on which the quote itself appears. Close your parentheses and add the closing punctuation.

To cite a newspaper article in MLA format, start by writing the author's last and first name, separated by a comma. Next, add the title of the article, ending with a period, and put the entire title in quotation marks.

As with other source types, an MLA citation for a newspaper article should include the author's surname and a page number for the specific part of the text cited: We discovered the artifact on an island in the Aegean Sea (Jones 32). Keep in mind that some newspapers are divided into sections with their own numbering.

Cite the newspaper article in MLA style starting with the title of the article. If there is no author name, begin with the title of the article in title case and in quotes with a period at the end, inside the quotes. Add the newspaper name in italics followed by the date of publication with day first, then month, then year and add a comma.

How to cite an online news article in APA style. (italicized) Fictional Newspaper, (not italicized) pp. A3-A6. Include the entire URL from which you retrieved the information, stating "Retrieved from [website] on [date]." Example: Micheli, C. (2010, April 20).

If you've cited a print version of a magazine or newspaper article, the information required in the reference list is as follows (if no author is named, as above, use the magazine/newspaper title): Surname, Initial(s).
