During the 2015-16 school year, one of the strategies that was introduced and modeled during MaRtl was this same strategy called number talks, but this time it focused on the middle grades. The resource that was provided to us was a book called "Making Number Talks Matter" by Cathy Humphreys and Ruth Parker.

Number Talks in High School | Five Twelve Thirteen

Number talks Intro: Computational fluency is a must for mastery of Common Core State Standards for math during the primary years. Number Talks for grades contains 170 bundled exercises for daily computation and/or problem solving practice to develop and refine accuracy.

Number Talks in High School: Dilemmas and Successes

Number talks were developed for classroom teachers to engage students in "mental math" through grappling with interesting mathematics problems. Educators can use number talks regularly as introductions to the day's mathematical practice, as "warm ups" for other lessons, or as stand-alone extended engagements with mathematical concepts.

Say and write the expression on board (horizontally)

I gave them a clue like the total number of corners or sides, and then they thought about what shape could be hidden and why they thought that. I thought it was a fun way to continue to build fluency and flexibility with numbers and to do some more shape recognition. It added a different context to our number talks. Thanks for the cards!
