Universal screening in pregnancy is currently not recommended, but is recommended for women with a higher risk of thyroid dysfunction . 1,7 Women with known thyroid disease will need to have their treatment adjusted and more frequently monitored during pregnancy (see Fig.).

Despite the impact thyroid diseases can have on a mother and baby, whether to test every pregnant woman remains controversial. As it stands, doctors recommend that all women at high risk for thyroid disease or women who are experiencing symptoms should have a TSH and an estimate of free thyroxine blood tests and other thyroid blood tests, if warranted.
