Professional leadership is increasingly recognised as being vital to enhancing social work's reputation and effectiveness. Although professional leadership is one of the nine domains of the professional capability framework in England, sometimes leadership is assumed to be the prerogative of managers rather than the responsibility of all professional social workers.

The Professional Capabilities Framework (PCF) applies to all social workers in England (including independent social workers), in all roles and settings . The PCF is an overarching professional standards framework, originally developed by the Social Work Reform Board, and now managed and delivered by BASW.
