If you spray epoxy and let it set for 24 hours you can lightly block sand it and your low spots will show up without any guide coat. Apply your filler right over the epoxy (no need to sand if done the next day) and when your repair is done spot prime the repairs with more epoxy.

Sand just enough to remove guide coat. If guide coat does not sand off in an area indicates a low and additional filler will be needed.  
•Optional: Either apply guide coat and block sand with 150 grit; Or, Apply a coat of finish glaze over entire repair area. Remember, glaze can be applied over sanded paint too.

Guide Coats A guide coat will show you if the panel is as flat and smooth as possible. What you want is a contrasting color. You don't need to cover the primer, just a mist coat is all that's needed. If you remove all the mist coat fairly evenly as you're sanding, that's good. If you are leaving areas that aren't sanded, those areas are low.
