Now, let's look at the frog's reproductive system. In female frogs, in the back of the body cavity are two ovaries, one on either side. These produce eggs that connect to the cloaca through a network of tubes called oviducts. In males, the testes make sperm, located towards the anterior portion of the kidney.
