The Bible's description of Solomon's Temple (also called The First Temple) suggests that the interior ceiling was 180 feet long, 90 feet wide, and 50 feet high. The highest point on the Temple Mount that Solomon built was actually 120 cubits tall (about 20 stories or about 207 feet).
