NICE guidelines on acute upper gastrointestinal bleeding ...

Upper gastrointestinal bleeding is gastrointestinal bleeding in the upper gastrointestinal tract, commonly defined as bleeding arising from the esophagus, stomach, or duodenum. Blood may be observed in vomit or in altered form as black stool. Depending on the amount of the blood loss, symptoms may include shock.

Acute upper gastrointestinal bleeding: management

Upper gastrointestinal bleeding (UGIB) is a common medical emergency, with a reported mortality of 2-10%. Patients identified as being at very low risk of either needing an intervention or death can be managed as outpatients.

Upper GI Bleeding The incidence of gastrointestinal hemorrhage ranges from 50 to 150 per 100 000 population each year. Reported mortality rates range from 11% to 33% for patients admitted primarily due to GI hemorrhage or who developed it as a complication of their hospital stay respectively.

What you need to know Bleeding from the upper gastrointestinal tract (oesophagus, stomach, and duodenum) occurs in approximately 100 per 100 000 people annually.¹² It is a medical emergency associated with substantial mortality. Acute upper gastrointestinal bleeding (UGIB) is common, but the annual incidence has been decreasing: from 78 to 61 cases in 100 000 persons from 2001 to 2009 in one survey . Nonetheless, 30-day mortality remains high, at up to 11% .

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
