Blooms Taxonomy questions

Before you set out to write your course outcomes and objectives, it is very helpful to understand Bloom's taxonomy and higher order thinking. Benjamin Bloom (1913-1999) is an educational psychologist who led the effort in developing a taxonomy that served as a framework for classifying learning objectives, i.e., what we expect students to learn as a result of instruction.

Verbs for Learning Objectives - Bloom's Taxonomy

Higher order thinking questions help students learn to understand, apply, analyze, evaluate, and CREATE information rather than simply recalling it. We've seen the ineffectiveness of memorizing grammar rules. We know it is important for students to actually understand and apply their grammar understanding to their writing.
